Many **women over 50** experience urinary changes, and it's easy to assume they're part of ageing, menopause, or another UTI.

If symptoms keep coming back or feel unusual, ask for further investigation - not just another course of antibiotics.

Know the early warning signs:

Common symptoms include:

- Blood in your urine (even once - always get it checked!)
- Frequent urination or sudden urges to pee
- Pain or burning when passing urine
- Recurring "UTIs" that don't get better with antibiotics
